

HUB OF THE HUNTER REGION


Newcastle serves as the ideal base for day trips to the picturesque Port Stephens or the iconic Hunter Valley wine region. With a myriad of venues welcoming visitors seven days a week and extending their services into the late evening hours, you'll find no shortage of options for entertainment and dining well into the night.

LOCATION

- 170km north of Sydney
- Direct regional Direct flights between major cities and many regional hubs
- Trains operate at regular intervals between Sydney and Newcastle Interchange and regional areas.

CLIMATE

The region enjoys warm summers and mild winters with an average temperature of 23 to 25°C or 73.4 to 77°F.

- Cruise on Newcastle Harbour and along the coastline
- Enjoy expansive views on a Bathers Way coastal walk

From opulent fine dining to a relaxed beach picnic, or cocktails overlooking the harbour to freshly brewed inner-city coffees, there are flavour filled experiences to suit all tastes and lifestyles. Local distilleries, farmers markets, award-winning chefs and hole-in-the-wall eateries unite to create an eclectic culinary experience for visitors.

 - Make a bespoke gin at an Earp Distilling Co. class •




SEEK THE COAST. EMBRACE THE CITY

With golden stretches of sand, such as the iconic Nobbys Beach and the surfer's paradise of Merewether Beach, this city invites you to unwind and embrace the laid-back Australian beach culture.



EXAMPLES:

- Surf one of Newcastle's iconic breaks at Nobbys or Bar Beach
- Walk the coastline paths and raised walkways along Bathers Way
- Visit Hickson St Lookout to admire beach views in bush surrounds
- Swim Merewether Ocean Baths, the southern hemisphere's largest ocean baths

EX SYDNEY 3 DAYS/2 NIGHTS NEWCASTLE





DAY ONE

Hire a car from Sydney or take the intercity rail and travel north to Newcastle. On arrival, be driven on a 18km loop around Newcastle by **Newy Tour Co** to get your bearings of the CBD and learn the history of this colourful coastal city.

Next head to nearby Darby Street for a bite to eat and to browse the shops and creative spaces. Enjoy dinner from one of the many restaurants along Newcastle foreshore, then embrace the night with a visit to the **Civic Theatre** for a show or grab a cocktail or two from a nearby boutique bar.

DAY TWO

After a morning at the beach, jump onboard **CoastXP** for an adventure cruise along the Newcastle coastline (between June-Nov you will be guaranteed humpback whale sightings).

For lunch head to the nearby Scratchleys for local seafood. In the afternoon choose your own adventure; head to **Earp Distilling Co.** for a gin tasting and making session or see Newcastle from above with a scenic helicopter tour with **Aero Logistics.**

For dinner, take a walk along Newcastle Harbour towards the Honeysuckle district where diners are spoilt for choice; Japanese, Italian, Mediterranean, Modern-Australian, Thai, it's all there.

DAY THREE

Morning surf lesson with **Newcastle Surfest Surf School** followed by lunch at Queens Wharf Hotel overlooking the Harbour. For the afternoon, follow the Bathers Way, one of the premier coastal walks in NSW, stretching 6km from Merewether Baths in the south to Nobbys Beach in the north. Upon checking out, travellers can either make their way to the Syndey or continue North on their Australian adventures.

DAY ONE

Embark on a tour of the city; by air with Aero Logistics, on the water with CoastXP, or by foot with Newcastle Afoot walking tours. Check into accommodation and enjoy a cocktail masterclass at Coal & Cedar before heading out for a beachside dinner at either Merewether Surfhouse or The Beach Hotel Merewether.



DAY TWO

Take a morning stroll along the beach and grab a coffee and light breakfast from Estabar. Once refreshed, get picked up from accommodation by **Daves Tours** and join a wine tour of the Hunter Valley before being returned to Newcastle.

Catch some live music at Rogue Scholar or taste local awardwinning brews from the crew at Modus Merewether.



DAY THREE

Take a morning surf lesson with Newcastle Surfest Surf School and then grab lunch along the Newcastle foreshore. Once finished, check out of your hotel and make the head back to Sydney or continue north to Port Stephens or Queensland.
